The Wisdom Motif of the Master Architect Twelfth Degree of the AASR, SJ

"Let us begin to rise from the earth toward the Stars." Such is the invitation of Albert Pike in the opening paragraph of his lecture to the Twelfth Degree, Master Architect.

Introduction

The Symbolic Lodge introduces the lesser mysteries of Freemasonry. Albert Pike considered the first three degrees to be a "preliminary and rudimental" introduction to symbolism, virtue, morality, history and the liberal arts and sciences. Truths and concepts "familiar to all men in all ages" were presented. Although perhaps satisfying and interesting, one can complete the first three degrees with the recognition that the ritual and symbols were presented not to reveal some Truth, but to conceal it; that the ritual merely offers "casual hints" and generalities.

The allegory of Freemasonry, the building motif described in the Winding Stairs lecture, continues into the Scottish Rite. Our degrees rely heavily on portions of the Volume of Sacred Law that describe the Temple of Solomon. The tools and instruments of its craftsman appear repeatedly as symbols for virtues, right action, and morality.

The saga of the Hiram Legend extends into the Scottish Rite. The story is expanded. We mourn and commemorate the death of our Grand Master. Workmen are selected to continue his work on the Temple. Justice is dispensed to the Ruffians, albeit differently than in the Symbolic Lodge. Steadily each degree becomes an "enigma to be solved, not a lesson to be read" or heard. A picture develops. It is a picture teaching us that we are not workmen learning to build a material edifice but men trying to build our character. We have not been using the operative mason's working tools to become proficient craftsmen or skilled workmen; we have been examining them as symbols of what it might

mean to be a good, decent human being. We learn "each man has a character of his own choosing." We have been toiling thus far so that we might choose well.

In Twelfth Degree, Master Architect, something changes. The building motif winds down. The Hiramic Legend completes its course, too.

Our focus is redirected from earthly matters, from the "realm of morality," virtue, and action toward the arena of philosophy and wisdom. In this degree, we look toward the Stars.

We realize, perhaps, that "what we came here to do," is to be concerned with the nature of reality, the Universe and philosophia, the love of wisdom. This degree clearly sets us upon a new course of thinking, reflection and action. This missive considers this new course and Twelfth degree's new motif – a wisdom motif.

Searching for Wisdom

In Judeo-Christian wisdom literature, from which the language in this degree is derived, four broad foundational concepts or attributes appear to guide our search for wisdom. First, the "fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge." "Fear" probably alludes to a reverence and devotion to Deity. Wisdom and the beginning of knowledge commence with an awareness of the vastness and complexity of the Universe and Nature.

This foundational starting point is not unique to Judeo-Christian literature. The Roman stoic philosopher Epictetus (55-135 CE) exhorted his students to "praise providence for everything that happens in the world...with a sense of gratitude in order to see the usefulness of the creation... [T]he first thing to learn is that God exists, that he governs the world...the next thing to learn about is the divine nature." Empedocles of Acragas states it negatively, "Wretched is he who cares not for clear thinking about the gods." Our journey toward wisdom begins with humility and reverence before and toward the Deity.

Secondly, wisdom inquiries about the general order of the Creation. "It gazes out and in...toward the general order built into creation: the limits to the water, circuits for the sun and moon...the change of season...to the musical score of" Nature. This degree redirects our "gaze" from the "what and how" of building something to the "why." The working tools of this degree remind us we have "ceased to work with the instruments of the laborer, the square, the level, the plumb, and the trowel, and assumed those of the Architect and Geometrician" to study the "heavens and the spheres," to advance toward philosophy.

Thirdly, wisdom discerns the order (or disorder) and circumstances in our lives. As we consider our role in the world and our duty, such discernment produces better decisions, supplies a freedom of judgment and encourages a broader, practical perspective. Such discernment teaches us that the reactions we have about what happens in our environment, and our judgments about them, are within our own influence and control. "It is not events that disturb people, it is their judgements (sic) concerning them." Epictetus reports that with discernment, "I can lift up my head like a free person in the face of circumstances... without fear of anything that might happen."

Wisdom helps us discern that our station in life or in the world matters not. "Wisdom is both for kings...and it also for individuals...Wisdom provides freedom" within the confines of our individual limits and environment. Pike notes that with wisdom, "The Peasant may be the real Monarch, the moral master of his fate, a free and lofty being, more than a Prince in happiness, more than a King in honor." (Associating freedom and wisdom is considered in Thirteenth and Fifteenth degrees.)

Finally, "wisdom is grounded in tradition." Tradition is a familiar idea to Masons, the "stories, customs, laws and values," the writings and sayings of the sages. Understanding traditions and history, in an era characterized by huge amounts of data and information and a vast diversity and array of opinion, is requisite. Remembering the instructions of the first circumambulation, we must seek the wise counsels referenced in Proverbs 1:5 and their obscure sayings.

Whether spiritual or secular, any historical practice that has shown itself "capable of binding men together... for any length of time [is] entitled to respect" and consideration. Acquiring wisdom does not require a man (or a generation) to start from scratch with first

principles. Instead a partnership may be made with "many generations" of experiences...between "those who are living...[and] those who are dead." In seeking wisdom, obtaining an understanding and knowledge of history and tradition is often more important than reason.

Our New Journey

The degrees of the Symbolic Lodge and the earlier degrees of the Lodge of Perfection used a building motif and the Hiramic Legend to help "choose" and develop our characters, to inculcate both value ethics and duty-based ethics. Such has been our journey from the lesser mysteries into the exploration of the greater mysteries.

The Hiramic Legend and building motif have completed their roles and we begin a new journey. In the Twelfth degree, the ritual employs a wisdom motif. We begin our study of philosophy, that singular "task of discovering the truth about the divine and human worlds..."

Whether we rely upon Judeo-Christian literature, the writings of Roman Stoics or eastern intellectual thought for our initial guidance, we begin with a foundation of reverence for and humility before Deity, our gaze is directed upward and outward, we discern and evaluate our circumstances and we recommit ourselves to the study of traditions and history.

Let us begin. Let us reach toward the Stars.

Our Spring Reunion was cancelled due to health considerations. We are scheduled again for October 17th and 24th. Watch the website, emails and this column for details and for degrees that may be conferred at Consistory meetings before the Reunion. In the meantime, wash your hands.

Peace and God's Blessings to all of you and your families. SHALOM!


