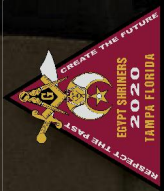

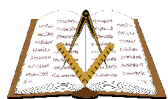

## Cracker Jacks

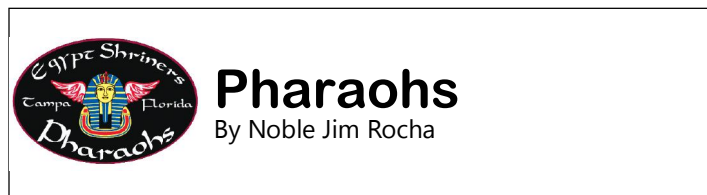

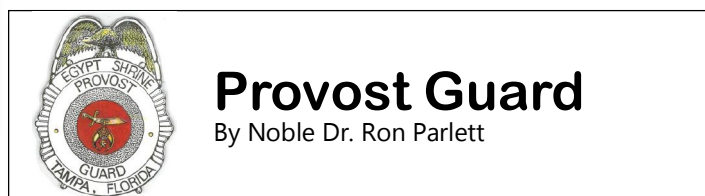
Current Pharaohs don't know that George started out in the Camel Patrol with Colen Franceschini. They lovingly put eye liner and lipstick on their Camels.

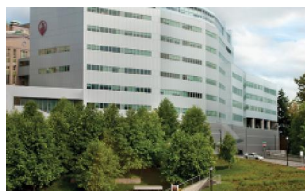

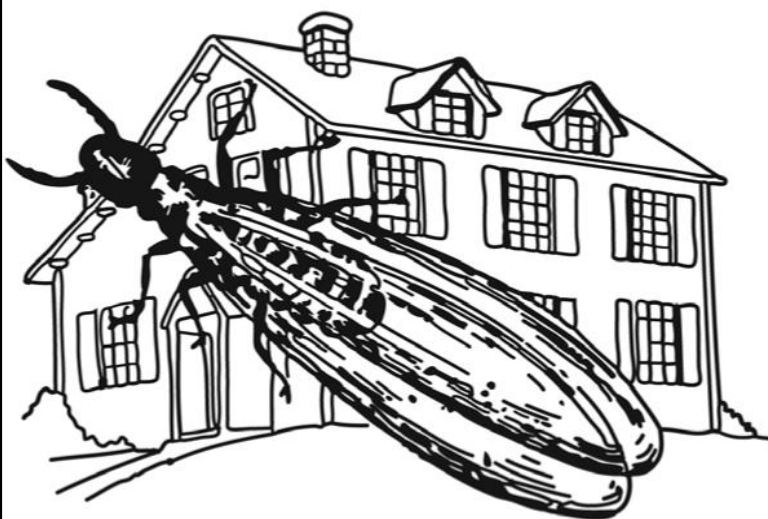
